DISCIPLESHIP THOUGHT FROM WORDS FOR WORSHIP.

In a stunningly private and intimate scene that occurs behind locked doors among dear friends, Jesus greets his disciples and shows them his wounds. Thomas is invited us to touch Jesus' wounds, to have his own life touched by the wounded and forgiving one. Jesus offers peace, and then he breathes into his companions. This is God's Spirit-breath—the breath that brings forth new life (Genesis 2:7), that makes human bodies alive again (1 Kings 17:17-24), that raises old bones into something new again (Ezekiel 37:9-10). Jesus is the one who calls us by name and embraces us with a kiss, lavish with life, with the gift of the Holy Spirit: God's presence that remains not outside of ourselves but rather dwells within us. This is divine intimacy that brings us back to life; love and peace have been poured out in us—peace that comes through the wounds of Jesus and by God's indwelling presence. Scars and Spirit—this is the heart of the new creation, a world full of people whose own wounds have been touched by Jesus, whose lives have become animated by God's own life and loving presence.
