DISCIPLESHIP THOUGHT FROM WORDS

FOR WORSHIP. There is so much that Jesus wants his people to know—more than time would afford, more than they could bear; sacred truths, deep mysteries (John 16:12). Jesus clearly knows that saying too much would overwhelm his followers, that the things of God are too counter-intuitive for them to try and place within their existing categories. But Jesus knows that the Holy Spirit will be given to them the Spirit of truth, who will guide them, like an inner compass, into all the truth (v. 13). The Holy Spirit is able to offer a kind and gentle inner consciousness, a way of engaging with new realities with great sensitivity and awareness. The Holy Spirit won't shock us into revelation. We're given time for our hearts to be made soft, space for our minds to become agile and flexible enough—a lifetime even! And then truth can come to us. Not forced on us from outside, but as a gift of being still with God, of sharing in God's consciousness—God's Spirit, our spirit, connected—truth from the inside-out, the beginning of a spiritual revolution (Ephesians 4:23); the mind of Christ worked into us (1 Corinthians 2:16)
