DISCIPLESHIP THOUGHT FROM WORDS

FOR WORSHIP. To truly follow Jesus is a risky commitment that challenges our normal securities and comforts. Jesus' followers experience this in the way they process the lack of receptivity shown by the Samaritan villagers they come across. They want to judge and condemn. They want to disregard them. But Jesus makes it known that peace with the outsider is only possible if they refuse to write off their 'enemies', if they can find a way to offer hospitality in place of hostility. Here, in this single episode, Jesus asks his followers to revise their relationship with their need to control and change others, with their need to cling to their own self-importance and status, with their desire to define clear insider/outsider relationships. Luke 9:51-62 will introduce further questions about the cost and call of discipleship. A would-be follower approaches Jesus and claims that he will follow him wherever he goes. Another man comes along who wants to follow Jesus but requests that he first go and bury his father. A third person encounters Jesus on the road and tells Jesus that he will follow but wants to go and say goodbye to his family first. Jesus brings challenges to each in turn. Jesus invites them to reckon with what they are really in for if they do indeed choose to join Jesus. Jesus never hides from us the way that participation in the ways of peace will involve a reckoning with our deepest allegiances and priorities.
