**DISCIPLESHIP THOUGHT FROM WORDS FOR WORSHIP.**

Following on from last week's reading, Paul outlines a few characteristics of Jesus. He explains that Jesus and God the creator are one, and Jesus is the head of the church and the fullness of God. As well as these divine qualities, Jesus was an embodied human, just like us. These were issues that were raised at the Council of Nicea 1700 years ago, from which we have the creed.

Today, these words still inspire us to connect to Jesus through God's word written in the Bible and share it with those around us. However, as much as we know, God remains a mystery, including precisely what Paul meant when he described Jesus as 'the image of the invisible God.' (Colossians 1:15)
