## **DISCIPLESHIP THOUGHT FROM WORDS**

**FOR WORSHIP.** Paul uses a range of metaphors in this passage to encourage the people of Colossae in their faith. One of the metaphors Paul uses is that of a plant or vine. Just as a healthy vine needs to have strong roots and be watered sufficiently to flourish, so too our faith needs to be rooted and nourished. When these conditions are met, then the fruit that will be born is thanksgiving for all that we have been fortunate enough to receive. A second metaphor is that of circumcision and the stripping away of what does not serve us. An extension of the previous gardening metaphor might speak of this as pruning. A healthy vine sometimes needs diseased branches or limbs removed for the health of the whole plant. Similarly, we can remove things from our lives that inhibit flourishing.
