### **DISCIPLESHIP THOUGHT FROM WORDS FOR WORSHIP.**

A reading from Philemon; the whole book is just twenty-one verses long. Within these verses, though, there is much food for thought. Paul writes the letter to beg for mercy for Onesimus, a runaway slave. Paul doesn't ask for his freedom, which, as a prisoner himself, Paul knows the value of. Rather, Paul asks the community to welcome Onesimus back as a brother, as if they were inviting Paul himself. What would we do if Onesimus were to come back to our community after having run away? Would we punish the runaway, or would we welcome them back as a sibling in Christ? What might it look like when we see Christ in each person in our community?
