DISCIPLESHIP THOUGHT FROM WORDS

FOR WORSHIP. Zacchaeus embodies the human curiosity and longing for God. He takes a chance and climbs a tree to see Jesus. Zacchaeus thought he was searching for God, only to discover that God was already searching for him. Jesus extends the divine hand of fellowship to the chief tax-collector—chief sinner—much to the dismay and outrage of the crowd. Zacchaeus comes down from his high place (a place of power, security, a place of refuge in a crowd for those considered national traitors), and welcomes Jesus into his home and life. This makes all the difference in Zacchaeus' life. Zacchaeus becomes free to give generously to the poor, free to make amends and take steps towards those he has wronged. This encounter with Jesus opens Zacchaeus up to God, to community, to generosity and justice.
