## **DISCIPLESHIP THOUGHT FROM WORDS**

**FOR WORSHIP.** Isaiah shares the stunning vision of the homemaking God: a unified people who have turned their back on the way of war, the seduction of power and might, who climb instead the holy mountain where God teaches God's ways of homemaking peace. Abraham Heschel in *The Prophets* writes, 'Into a world fascinated with idolatry, drunk with power, bloated with arrogance, enters Isaiah's word that the swords will be beaten into plowshares, that nations will search, not for gold, power, or harlotries, but for God's word.' Jerusalem becomes what it was always intended to be—the city of shalom, the city of peace—a people no longer formed by a pervasive culture of death.

Here, God judges and deals fairly and equitably among the nations. Weapons of war are transformed into instruments of peace; destructive energies are made constructive. All things are enabled to reach their true, life-giving potential, helping to usher in a creation-wide flourishing of all things. Here is the biblical hope, the call to live in a new reality. Here is a profound picture of salvation: the wonderful movement from violence to peace, from domination to compassion, from despair to the shalom-justice of the homemaking God.
