DISCIPLESHIP THOUGHT FROM WORDS FOR WORSHIP.

² Peter's recollection of the moment of Jesus' transfiguration might be an interesting reframe of a story well known to many in the Christian church. Let's not forget that we need the wisdom of the scholars, the teachers, the ones immersed in ways to interpret the Bible, to help us cross thousands of years to symbols and tropes of an ancient revelation form of story. Mountains, light, and clouds alert an ancient audience: God is revealing God's self here. The appearance of Moses and Elijah links to the ancient holy people of God and two of their most revered prophets, through whom God was known and heard. Falling to one's face is another expected embodied response of those encountering the presence, the direct voice of God. Further, as scripture—this sacred inheritance of story and symbol—is not a matter of one's own interpretation, we also need Spirit to help us discern. This moment of profound Divine revelation shows us why our alignment with Wisdom, the focus of recent weeks, is vital. How can we hope to understand God's self-revelation in moments like this if we are not immersing ourselves in Wisdom's teaching, not practicing attentiveness to God's self-revelation through Wisdom, every day?
