DISCIPLESHIP THOUGHT

Jesus speaks to his disciples as he prepares them for a world that may not welcome them. He names the risks of discipleship plainly—misunderstanding, division, loss, and fear—and does not pretend that following him will preserve comfort or the status quo. It is in this demanding context that Jesus offers words of deep reassurance: you are seen, you are known, and you are valued. If God's care extends even to the sparrows, then it also holds those who are called to navigate a costly path of faithfulness.

This is not a promise of safety, but a promise of presence—that we are not alone in what we are asked to bear. Discipleship, in this passage, is not about avoiding difficulty, but about trusting that our lives are held even as they are given. As Paul writes in Romans 6:1b–11, we are drawn into a pattern of dying and rising—letting go of what secures us in order to live more fully in God's life. Where might we be called beyond what is familiar or comfortable? As we receive the reassurance of God's care, how might we offer this care where division, marginalisation, or the weight of faithful witness is felt?
