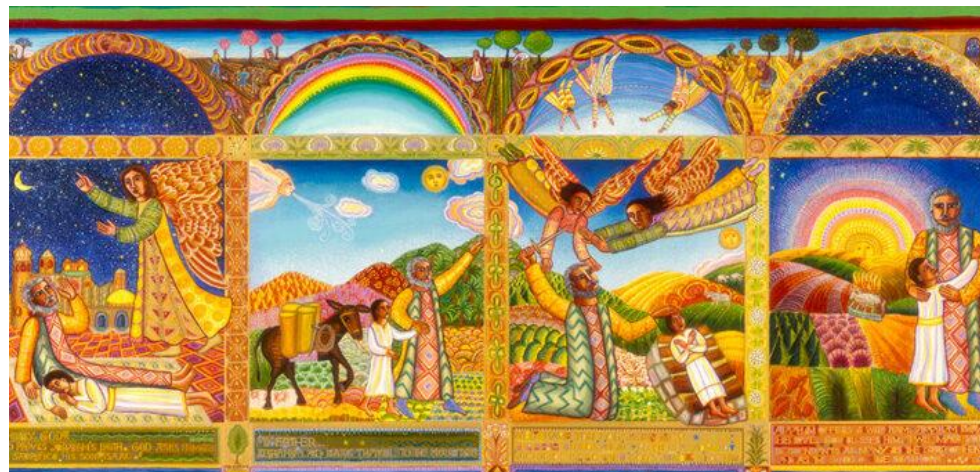
Discipleship Thought

Matthew 10:40–42 invites us to consider what discipleship requires—not only of those who are sent, but also of those who receive them. Jesus speaks of welcome in the context of costly discipleship. Those who go in his name may face rejection or misunderstanding and depend on the willingness of others to receive them. Even a small act of hospitality, such as offering a cup of cold water, becomes an act of alignment—a choice to stand with Christ's followers.

These verses remind us that disciples are not only those who offer welcome, but those who must also receive it. Faithful witness depends on mutual care, shared vulnerability, and openness to one another. Where might we be called to welcome others—and to recognise Christ present among those we might otherwise overlook?

Frontier Services - Thanks to all who supporter our soup fundraiser last week. A total of \$170 was raised. Our next fundraiser will be in September with our usual BBQ after our special Frontier Services worship.

Working Bee - At this stage no special date has been set, however there are jobs that need to be done before our big one in September. If you can spare some time and attend to some of these jobs when it suits you it would be much appreciated. Please advise Col or Gail if you can help out. Please don't forget to enter your details in the volunteer book hanging at the back door. **Prune (cut back) Hydrangeas, weed garden on North Side of hall, pick up sticks and stones, mop hall floor. Some weeding of gardens at the manse would be appreciated.**

Maintenance that has been done - Thanks to Col for attending to and arranging for the following things to be done - The outside spotlight has been disconnected and removed which will make mowing easier. Trees have been trimmed to avoid leaves blocking gutters. A new roof and gutters have been installed on the front hall. Front double gates have been removed and sold. At the manse, gutters and roof valleys have been cleaned. Ongoing work is needed on the roof and verandas. Downpipes at the manse have been cut off and water redirected, quite a bit of vegetation was removed to have access to pipes.

Maintenance to be done. A quote has been sought to paint the ceilings in the front alcoves of the hall. Replacement of kitchen roof, solar panels and manse garage roof is "works in progress" with the Insurance company. Trusting that work can start soon
