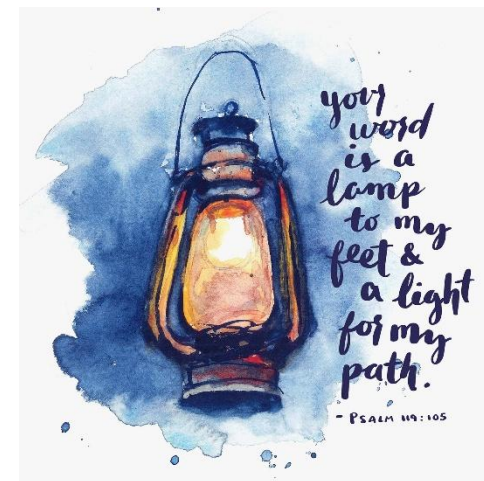

Discipleship Thought - Words for worship

Who did Jesus see as he borrowed a boat and launched out for a broader look at the crowd so eager to hear him? He sees people who are soon to be plucked from among his followers, like freshly fallen seed snatched by hungry birds: are they too happy-go-lucky to be bothered with Jesus' teaching or too self-willed to change? But not all. He notices those whose lives are parched, like seedlings deprived of good soil: do they choose convenience over commitment? But not all. He knows that many will become preoccupied and overrun with the daily demands of life, like plants choked by weeds: will personal gain or comfort take priority over the needs of others and devotion to God? But not all. He perceives that among this crowd are those who will have productive lives, like the crop that produces grain in varying amounts: will they persevere when life is tough, showing kindness, justice, love and care even when it is difficult? If we were there on the lake shore, where would we stand in the crowd?

Working Bee - At this stage no special date has been set, however there are jobs that need to be done before our big one in September. If you can spare some time and attend to some of these jobs when it suits you it would be much appreciated. Please advise Col or Gail if you can help out. Please don't forget to enter your details in the volunteer book hanging at the back door. **Prune (cut back) Hydrangeas, weed garden on North Side of hall, pick up sticks and stones, mop hall floor. Some weeding of gardens at the manse would be appreciated.**

Maintenance that has been done - Thanks to Col for attending to and arranging for the following things to be done - The outside spotlight has been disconnected and removed which will make mowing easier. Trees have been trimmed to avoid leaves blocking gutters. A new roof and gutters have been installed on the front hall. Front double gates have been removed and sold. At the manse, gutters and roof valleys have been cleaned. Ongoing work is needed on the roof and verandas. Downpipes at the manse have been cut off and water redirected, quite a bit of vegetation was removed to have access to pipes.

Maintenance to be done. A quote has been sought to paint the ceilings in the front alcoves of the hall. Replacement of kitchen roof, solar panels and manse garage roof is "works in progress" with the Insurance company. Trusting that work can start soon
